

# **Information for Year 14**

### Time to reply to UCAS offers!

As all students applied before January 31st, all university decisions will be made by May 16th.

Students who do not receive any offers can apply to additional courses through UCAS Extra which is available until 4th July. Any students, who wish to know more about this, speak to your Careers teacher.

## 2024 entry cycle

Last decision by: 16th May 2024 Your reply deadline is: 6th June 2024

Make decisions wisely. Choose your Conditional/Firm offer from the course you would most prefer to study, providing you can achieve the entry requirements. Your Conditional Insurance offer should be used as a 'back up' if you achieve lower grades than you expect but make sure it is still a course or university where you want to study.

It is not advisable to be holding two offers with the same entry requirements.

If you have received an unconditional offer, think carefully before accepting it.

### **Student Finance**

All Year 14 students and parents will have received information regarding Student Finance. Applications for Student Finance should be done online at: www.studentfinanceni.co.uk

If applying for Student Finance, application forms and evidence should be submitted by end of April to ensure funds are available when your course starts. Applications after this date, will still be accepted but there may be a delay receiving allocated finances. When applying to university, all students are eligible to apply to Student Finance to receive grants and or loans from Student Finance NI. A short parent guide is available on the College website. # **Information for Year 13**

All Year 13 students will attend UCAS Higher Education Exhibition on 25th April, giving students the opportunity to speak to universities from the UK and Ireland. I would encourage students to attend Open Days of any university of interest. All students will have the opportunity to attend QUB, Ulster University and St Mary's University Belfast Open Days in September/October 2024. Various information events for both parents and students will become available throughout the year. These can be found on each university website and I would encourage you to attend, if possible. Students should continually check their school email account for additional events.

# **UCAS 2024-25**

In September 2024, the Careers Department will host a UCAS Information Evening to help parents understand the process and help prepare your son/daughter for the year ahead. There will be a number of meetings for these students, and it is important students attend these meetings to discuss their application. Students should make sure that they are preparing fully for these very competitive courses, by showing initiative in their independent learning around their chosen subject.

# Information for Year 12

All students have completed their one-to-one interview with the College Careers Advisor and should have received a copy of their Action Plan. Students also need to complete and submit their Personal Career Plan (PCP) to their Careers teacher by the end of this term. Year 12 students should also be researching possible career plans. This can be done using Career Ideas and A-Z of Careers, available via My School at home or Xello, available only in school.
