Year 11 students in Our Lady and St. Patrick's College, Knock will sit GCSE exams in a number of subjects. The number of exams taken will be determined by your subject choices.

English Language, English Literature, Geography, Maths, History, Technology and Double Award Science are just some of the subjects completing a module at the end of Year 11.

Students will be entered by their teacher and receive an individual examination timetable detailing the times and dates of their exams in February.

Fees

Students should note that the College pays the fees the first time they sit their exams. If a student fails to turn up for an exam, the College will still be expected to pay for that exam. It is important therefore that candidates inform the College if they are unable to sit an exam. Students will be asked to provide medical evidence to explain their absence. If a doctor's letter is not provided, the student will be required to pay the exam fee.
