

A2 students sit their final set of exams in the summer of Year 14. Each individual will be sitting a varied combination of A2 exams and AS re-sits. No two students in a class will be the same. It is vital, therefore that all A-Level students examine their individual statements of entry and timetables. If they have any questions about their entries, they should speak to Ms O'Connor in the Examinations office. Correcting errors after the published deadline, usually costs money.

### **Clashes**

When candidates receive their timetable some individuals may find that two of their exams are scheduled to start at exactly the same time. This is unfortunate but unless the total for the two exams goes **over three hours** they will simply sit the exams one after the other.

If the total time for the two exams goes over three hours, a timetable variation will have to be made. This means the candidate will sit one exam in the morning, followed by a period of isolation. The candidate will be able to have lunch and study for their afternoon exam but they will be supervised throughout. **STUDENTS SHOULD BE AWARE THAT NO MOBILE PHONES OR ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE ALLOWED DURING THE PERIOD OF ISOLATION.**

It is important that the candidate discusses the arrangements for isolation with Ms O'Connor in advance of the exam
